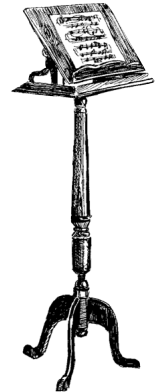
Submit your nomination now and mark your calendar for Arts Day, March 3, 2010. Nominating is easy...recognizing deserving candidates is important.
